

## Our vision is a future where all corporate boards are gender-balanced and diverse

Currently, 517 the Russell 3000 public companies have only one or zero women on their boards, and women of color make up only 7% of the total seats. At the current pace women are not expected to hold 50% of the corporate board seats until the year 2033!




**Quarterly & Annual Distribution.**
