

Dr. Jellinek served as Chief of Child Psychiatry at Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) from 1979 until 2007 and is Professor of Psychiatry and of Pediatrics at Harvard Medical School. With Michael Murphy, Ed.D., he developed the Pediatric Symptom Checklist, which is a widely used brief screening questionnaire to help primary care pediatricians identify children with emotional problems which is widely used in the United States and translated in 36 languages. Dr. Jellinek has served as Senior Vice President for Administration at Massachusetts General Hospital; President, Newton Wellesley Hospital; (2001-2012); Chief Clinical Officer, Partners HealthCare (2012-2014), and CEO, Community Network and EVP, Lahey Health System. In 2017, Dr. Jellinek founded Ulysses Consulting, LLC, and serves as a management consultant to CEOs and senior managers. Dr. Jellinek served as an Adjunct Professor of Social Policy and Management at the Heller School, Brandies University and has taught in the MD/MBA program. He has served on non-profit boards (Newton Wellesley Hospital, Heller School at Brandies, and William James College) and private, for-profits (Ocean's HealthCare, ButcherBox, HughesApp).
