#### Executive Summary

At STFC, Kym was Chair of the Investment Committee and served on the Audit, Compensation, and Independent Committees until it was acquired in March of 2022. At PIMCO, she Chairs the Valuation Oversight Committee and is a member of the Audit, Governance, and Investment Committees. At Point B, LLC Kym Chairs the Nominating & Governance Committee (N&G) and is a member of the Compensation Committee.
