Denise serves on the Board of Tractor Supply Company (TSCO:NASDAQ), the country's largest rural lifestyle retailer where she is Chair of the Governance Committee, a member of the Compensation Committee and was on the Audit Committee. TSCO is a Fortune 300 company with over 2,500 stores and 50,000 employees. During her tenure as Committee Chair, the Committee has led the successful and planned Board refreshment and leadership rotation. The TSCO Board and Management have navigated a fluid external environment through a commitment to its mission and values. The TSCO Board has been named as the Best Board in Retail by Institutional Investor and has been recognized for its diversity.

Denise previously served as a director of PipelineRx, an early stage telepharmacy technology and services company, where she was Chair of its Compensation Committee. Denise also served as Board Chair of Girls on the Run International, a multimillion-dollar non-profit.
